Resurfacing the site and provision of new internal road markings will improve traffic throughput and separate the residents using the facility from vehicles which will improve site safety. 6 Alternative options considered and rejected:

**Option I** – Do nothing,

The Environment Agency will issue an improvement notice potentially leading to prosecution and forced closure of the site.

**Option 2** (Preferred Option) – Install a new drainage system new access steps and undertake resurfacing to prevent enforcement action by the Environment Agency.

**Option 3** – CCTV, ANPR Improved welfare facilities

To undertake the works as described in Option 2 to meet the legal requirements set by the environment agency as well as make other improvements to the site operation resulting in improved health & safety for site users and staff.
