	To support infrastructure delivery and priority project delivery, in particular Forder Valley Interchange (Total funding = \pounds 8.83M, CIL funding = \pounds 3.83M) and North Prospect Phase 5 (Total funding = \pounds 13.4million, CIL funding = \pounds 950K)
	Individual Delegated Officer sign off required as dictated by original approved business case which set out the principles which govern the allocation of Community Infrastructure Levy receipts.
6	Alternative options considered and rejected:
	The main purpose of the List is to provide transparency around what the Council intends to fund through CIL and what site specific infrastructure Section 106 contributions will continue to be used for. The intention is to ensure that there is no duplication in the use of both CIL and Section 106 for the same project.
	Use of Section 106 funding has been considered but as funding is largely dependent on development progressing, use of Section 106 receipts is not a preferred option.
