Chemical Agent Attack

Plymouth City Council strongly supports the stance the British Government has taken with Russia over the recent appalling chemical agent attack in Salisbury.

Russia has questions to answer about their involvement and its' dismissive attitude on the seriousness of this issue requires strong action from the Prime Minister in response.

The City Council re-affirms its' commitment to do everything possible to keep the people of Plymouth safe.

This Council resolves to:

- a) Instruct the CEO to write to the Prime Minister Theresa May supporting the strong action taken in relation to Russia over this very serious issue.
- b) Revoke any official invitations to the City to Russian Officials until this matter is resolved.
- c) Record its' overwhelming dismay that, despite support from MPs of all parties, Jeremy Corbyn failed to back the government's conclusion that the Russian State was culpable for the attempted murder of Mr Skirpal and his daughter.
