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# Synopsis

The Inspector agreed that the development would be overtly urban in appearance; more appropriate to a built-up area than the existing loose pattern of development in the vicinity of the site, contrary to policies CS01, CS16 and CS18 of the Core Strategy. In terms of sustainability the Inspector found that the scheme is not significantly different to the allowed scheme for two houses on the site, i.e. there are good facilities in the nearby built-up area and the lack of pedestrian and bus facilities near the site would not be a significant impediment. No overall conflict with policies CS01 and CS28. The 4 dwellings provide housing in the face of a lack of supply in the city but the harm to the character of the area and the carbon emmisions from car use would outweight those benefits. The Joint Local Plan was given little weight owing to the absence of any information regarding the extent to which there are unresolved objections to relevant policies.

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
