Delivery of the Plymouth Road Junction improvements

In 2015 Plymouth City Council was successful in securing £2.1m direct grant from the Department of Transport through the Heart of the South West Local Enterprise Partnership for Growth Deal I funding to deliver the Eastern Corridor Junction Improvements Programme.

The scheme is primarily focussed on renewing the existing and aging traffic signal infrastructure and equipment in use for the signal-controlled junctions along the eastern corridor including Plymouth Road in Plympton thereby increasing capacity along these arterial routes.

Delivery of the Plymouth Road improvements was scheduled to start in-the summer 2018, but following the re-election of a Labour Council this has now been unnecessarily delayed.

The City Council resolves to request the Cabinet to implement forthwith the publicly consulted and agreed scheme for Plymouth Road, its various junctions including Cot Hill and also the Merafield Road and Cot Hill junction which is vital to addressing increased traffic along Haye Road.
