**Fly tipping cases reported to Plymouth City Council**

Between 5<sup>th</sup> May 2018 to 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2019: 3,033 cases were reported to the council.

Evidence sufficient to issue FPN's was found in 62 cases.


The Council are not awarded fines; these are paid to the Courts. Costs are awarded to the Council by the Courts on a case by case basis.
